Going into the season we had some new coaches with Curt Forbrock taking over the Legion Gold team (Chris Peters retired from coaching after a tremendous coaching career at the helm of the Gold team including many State Tournament appearances, winning our own summer Classic and a 2nd place finish at the prestigious Gopher Classic), Trevor Slette taking over the head coach's position for VFW Gold and our own Mark Grossmann returning to lead the VFW Silver team.

All Three teams represented New Ulm baseball very well both on and off the field, with Legion Gold finishing second in Sub-State, beating Mankato National twice, but coming up short against Mankato American in the championship. Mankato went on to take 3rd at State. VFW Gold started slow however showed tremendous improvement as the season progressed with a strong finish at Districts. No Vehicle Tax Update. We have just learned that the Vehicle Registration/Tax Exemption for 100% Disabled Veterans will not begin until July 1, 2024. We have validated that those who receive Individual Unemployability will not be allowed (by the DMV) to have this benefit. Efforts continue to inform legislators of this situation, and a change can be passed in the 2024 session before the benefit begins.

The Lafayette American Legion invites you to attend a Veteran/Community Park dedication on Sunday, September 17, at 1600 hours. A brief outdoor program will be followed by a lunch at the Lafayette Community Center. Their new memorial is located adjacent to Dave's Place.

The State Veterans Cemetery at Redwood Falls is now open and taking applications for burial. Both Veterans and their Spouses may be buried or interred at any State Vets Cemetery. There is no cost for the Veteran, and \$750 is the cost for a spouse, or dependent child. Call 507-709-4390 or visit them at 33752 Noble Ave (Hwy 71 beside John Deere dealer).

Texas Wild Hog Hunt. Travel to South Texas in March of 2024 for a five-day all-expenses paid hunting trip with the Disabled American Veterans of Minnesota; DAV membership is NOT required. Hunting will be hunting in the evenings under lights, so we will see plenty of hogs coming out. If you have never hunted hogs, this may be your trip. Veterans will hunt every other day so that there is a day of rest in-between days of hunting so that no one gets burned out. The other days can be spent fishing in the pond at our house or playing cards, pool, or other games in the game room. 
