#### BR. CO. VETERAN'S SERVICE NEWS —

Greg Peterson Brown County Courthouse Veterans Office Sells Veterans Van.

The nicely decorated County owned Veterans Van has been sold to the Brown County Probation Department for \$18,000. This decision was made by Service Officer Greg Peterson because the Veterans Office has been running a Federally owned van since September last, and the County owned van was just sitting without being used. The Probation Department has already removed all of the "wrappings" which returned the 2017 Ford Transit to a plain white van. In its place is a 2019 Ford Transit van that is owned by the Federal Government and can take riders to any VA scheduled appointment at any location. This van is wrapped with DAV logos and is often called a DAV van, but it's not. Here's how that program works: The National DAV organization buys fleets of Ford vehicles and donates them to VA Hospitals around the Nation. The VA registers vans with plates and puts a credit card in with the key and hands the vans back to the DAV to "operate." 204326083

In Minnesota the DAV places those vans with County Veterans Service Officers who provide the drivers. Through this new program the County gets the van for free (VA pays for gas & maintenance), and the rider no longer pays a fee to ride, they also don't get to collect travel pay. The \$18,000 received from the "sale" to the Probation Department will be used to pay our driver's salary for the next couple of years. We have some funds in reserve, but I anticipate that we will need to seek donations from our 9 County Vets Organizations at some point.
