Attention Widow's/Survivors on DIC.

Widow's or Widower's who receive the VA's Dependency and Indemnity Compensation (DIC) can now ask for an "Earlier Effective Date," if the Widow applied for Social Security benefits on or after January 1, 1957. Under this obscure VA law, those individuals receiving DIC will be paid based on the date they applied for Social Security even if the Veteran was alive at the time of the application for Social Security. For example: Spouse applies for SSA on 1 May 2006 and the Veteran passes on 1 May 2009 from a Service Connected condition (agent orange for example). Under normal circumstances the widow's payment would have been calculated from 1 May 2009. But! The widow can, at any time ask for her effective date to be made earlier, May 2009 in this example. When the VA grants the new effective date the widow will get a very large retro-active payment equal to two years of the benefit. This would roughly be: \$32,000 in tax-free money. The key idea to remember is that the widow had to have applied for SSA before applying for DIC. The application is a simple statement asking for the benefit and we are standing by to assist. If you have any documentation from SSA showing the date you applied, we would need that. You can also call SSA at: 800-772-1213 and ask them to send you documentation of when you applied for SSA. Don't hesitate to apply, the VA cannot deny you or take away what you have already. Greg & John


