You can call 507-354-6822 (toll free 800-767-7139), stop by the local office at 1618 South Broadway, Suite 203, New Ulm, or go to www.mnvac.org for the application forms. Help yourself, your neighbor, your friends, your family, and fellow veterans by getting this information out to help them access the MNVAC EAP funds. While MN can get to +100 degrees in the summer, it still gets -30 degrees in the winter. We all need affordable heat in the winter. Pass it on.

The 2022 Legislative Session begins on 31 January. This year your Department Commanders are requesting the following from our Legislators:

More funding for the Departments. Pay a Military Bonus to Post 9/11 Veterans. Give Posts 100% property tax relief. Reduce hunting, trapping, and fishing licenses for disabled Veterans.

Eliminate 2-year window for Widows receiving DIC to apply for property tax exclusions. Provide a percentage based property tax relieve starting with 50% disabled Veterans. Change the definition of a Veteran to include disabled Guard and Reservists. We expect a Veterans Day on the Hill rally to be in April, pending any Covid restrictions.

We need more van drivers; daily pay is now near \$100 depending on hours driven. Call John Schotzko if interested: 507-233-6636.


