

More Veterans & Widows Eligible for Benefits.

The war-time dates have been expanded under Public Law 116-315 for any military member who was in Vietnam or in Vietnam waters one or after November1, 1955. This new rule change expands the "in-country" and "blue waters" dates by nearly 9 years. We are looking for any living Veteran who was either on the soil, or in the waters of Vietnam between these dates as you are now eligible for assisted living and nursing home payment assistance.
