COVID Vaccines are available for multiple age groups at the Minneapolis VA (866-414-5058, press #2, and #2 again), Shakopee VA Clinic (952-445-4070). Minneapolis has given 31,000 shots so far.

COVID Vaccines are available for multiple age groups at the St. Cloud VA) 800-247-1739. Vaccines are also available for Brown County Veterans 65+ (who live in the County). Please call our office to sign up: 507-233-6636 or 233-6637. Shots for County residents began on Feb 20th.

Federal funding for 3-new Veterans Homes in Alex, Monti, and Preston has been delayed. It is hoped that construction can start by October 2022. Peterson leads efforts to allow traditional national guard soldiers and reservists to receive the "Veteran" designator on their driver's licenses. CVSO Greg Peterson recently meet with the MN House Representative Mike Sundin to amend a bill that wanted to remove the requirement to actually be a Veteran to get the Veteran designation placed on MN Driver's Licenses. In a compromise effort to maintain the Veteran requirements, Greg Peterson suggested that the Veteran designation also be provided for the National Guard and Reservists who don't technically meet the State's definition of a Veteran. If the bill becomes law, it will likely go into effect on 1 July and those persons will require certified copies of their documents before the License Bureau can issue the LD.

Veterans on the Hill will be a completely virtual event now to be called: Week of Advocacy. Minnesota Military Radio will host two programs on Saturday and Sunday, April 10 & 11. American Legion Posts will be encouraged to host a virtual meeting with their legislators the following week (12-16 April). Is Post 132 up to this challenge?
