Attention Widows Receiving DIC. If you applied for Social Security Survivors Benefits before you applied for DIC, please contact your County Veterans Service Officer to apply for an "earlier effective date" to your DIC award. We have discovered a loop-hole that allows widows to received thousands of dollars in a lump-sum retro-active payment. Common cases where this may apply to you would be: Navy Vet dies of an Agent Orange disease before the 2019 VA recognized Naval service in the "blue waters" of Vietnam. Or, Veteran died of ALS before the 2008 VA adopting ALS as a service connected disease. Or, widow was simply unaware that the Veteran died of a condition leading to the award of Dependency & Indemnity Compensation (DIC) and had/has never applied. Legal Reference: Title 38, United States Code, 5105(b).


