The Avenue of Flags program was started in the 1970's and has continued to grow. Burial flags are donated by family members and there is a cost for the pole. The full-page article in the New Ulm Journal prior to Memorial Day lists the names of those veterans whose flag has been presented. BRONZE FLAG STAFFS AND FLAGS will be placed in the Veterans Section of City Cemetery on Thursday, May 27 at 9:00 AM. We cannot place the bronze staffs in other parts of the cemeteries – they must be placed by family members – but someone will be at the cemetery to assist with flags and staffs as follows: Saturday, May 29, 10:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M. • Sunday, May 30, 10:00 to Noon The Memorial Day program will be at 10:00 AM on Memorial Day, May 31, 2021 in the New Ulm City Cemetery, Lower Soldier's Rest.

If you are unable to attend a local Memorial Day program. Minnesota Department of Veteran Affairs (MDVA) will hold a virtual Memorial Day program again this year. MDVA will again partner with Twin Cities PBS-TPT to create a 30-minute Memorial Day program entitled "Reflections: Memorial Day 2021" that will be broadcast across the state on TPT's Minnesota Channel at 8 p.m. on Monday, May 31.

Permit to Carry Fee

The Brown County Board of Commissioners approved the request to set the PERMIT TO CARRY fee for veterans, National Guard members, Reservists, or active duty of U.S. Armed Forces at \$25.00 for any new or renewal applications.

New FEE SCHEDULE:

\$100.00 Permit	to Carry – New
\$75.00	Permit to Carry - Renewal (Prior to 90 days of expiration)
\$85.00	Permit to Carry (Up to 30 days of expiration)
\$10.00	Permit to Carry (Duplicate Permit to Carry/Address Change)
\$25.00	Permit to Carry - U.S. Military Veteran/U.S. Military active
	duty (new or renewal)*

\*Forms of proof of military service would include: a Minnesota driver's license with the VETERAN endorsement (note: the veteran has to supply documents to DPS to get this veteran endorsement), an active U.S. Military identification card, a U.S. Military DD-214 with a discharge of honorable, a member of a National Guard or Reserve Component who has honorably completed their first full term of service as reflected on a copy of their DD-214, or NGB form 22.

This is a small token of appreciation by the Brown County Sheriff's Office to honor and recognize the men and women who have served our country by serving in the U.S. Military.
