BR. CO. VETERAN'S SERVICE NEWS —

Greg Peterson Brown County Courthouse 507-233-6636 COVID-19 Relief Grants. The MN Legislature has appropriated \$6.2 million dollars as a Stimulus package for Minnesota Veterans. Only one other State in the Nation is helping Veterans, Indiana is the other. All applicants must submit evidence of a Financial Loss, which could be a letter from their employer stating a reduction in hours, or confirmation that the Veteran is receiving Unemployment Insurance, or a history of pay stubs showing a reduction in working hours, or you have a financial impact due to the closing of colleges, secondary, or pre-school/day cares. All financial losses must have occurred on or after 3/13/2020 which is when the Governor's Emergency Stay at Home Order went into effect. Applications for the \$1,000 grant can be found and submitted on line at minnesotaveteran.org. There is another grant valued up to \$3,000 called a COVID-19 Special Needs Grant. Eligibility is the same, but this grant will pay directly to your creditors; examples are: pay rents or mortgage, property taxes, auto loans, medical bills, medical insurance, home or auto repairs, hearing aids, furnace or air conditioning units. Both programs are directed at working Veterans or Surviving Spouses. Your loss in the stock market, or grain markets, or other values of savings or retirement funds does not qualify.

Your CVSOs (John Schotzko & Greg Peterson) are available for phone calls and will help you with either application. Please call first.

As of 4/21, the Courthouse is scheduled to remain closed through 3 May, reopening on Monday, May 4th.


