Funding for Redwood Veterans Cemetery Approved. The US Department of Veterans Affairs has announced that they are awarding \$5.9 million dollars to the MN Department of Veterans Affairs for the construction of a State Veterans Cemetery at Redwood Falls. Construction is slated to begin in later 2021 with a completion and burials starting in 2023. Burials are free for Veterans and \$745 for a spouse. Burial arrangements are currently made between the cemetery and the next of kin. A military discharge document, commonly called the DD214 is required for all burials and Veteran are encouraged to complete a pre-registration application to validate their eligibility. These forms are available on-line at the MDVA Cemeteries website. Your County Veterans Service Officer also has these forms and will complete them for you. Vaults are pre-placed in the ground and are not required to be purchased from the funeral home. Cremations will be placed in either an in ground burial, or in an above ground columbarium. The cemeteries will allow fresh cut flowers to be placed on the graves at any time and will be removed by the staff when they become faded or unsightly. This new cemetery will also bring several permanent jobs to the RWF area. An administrative staff and grounds keepers will be hired and Veterans will be encouraged to apply. National Guard Retirees: If you are under age 60 and have a VA Disability Rating, you are eligible to apply for the Combat Related Special Compensation (CRSC) from your branch of Service. CRSC is a monetary benefit which is paid by the branch of service, is non-taxable and allows you to start collecting before reaching your normal retirement pay age. Applications are made on the DD Form 2860 which can be found many places on-line; DFAS is the best resource. Your County Veterans Service Officers also offer application assistance and we recommend that you find your CVSO at: macvso.org and make an appointment to find out if you're a good candidate for CRSC.
