### BR. CO. VETERAN'S SERVICE NEWS — Greg Peterson Brown County Courthouse 507-233-6636

We are building a database of all Navy & Marine Corps personnel who served within 12 nautical miles of the South Vietnam coastline during the Vietnam War (Jan 9, 1962 to May 7, 1975). On January 29th the US Court of Appeals ruled in favor of a 73-year old Navy Veteran and an estimated 90,000 other Veterans who served off the coast of Vietnam within the dates and miles as specified. This court ruling extends the "presumption" of Agent Orange exposure to these Veterans. Presumption means that if a Veteran has, or has died from any of the 50 diseases on the Agent Orange list, can receive monetary compensation, or widow's compensation. There are also educational benefits for children living in Minnesota whose parent died from an Agent Orange condition. Please contact our office for more information: 507-233-6636.
