Attention Gray Area Guard & Reserves: Your military components are no longer mailing Retiree Application Packages prior to you reaching age 60. You are now responsible to call and request a Retirement application within this window of time: 9 months prior to, or 90 days after attaining age 60. The contact telephone for all branches of the military are: 651-268-4510 or 651-268-8188.

In addition to being responsible for your own Retirement package, the military no longer automatically enrolls you into Tricare and you should request this through the 8188 number above. If you have been on Tricare and have recently added a new spouse, or new children it is also your responsibility to notify Tricare that you want to enroll in their services. Their phone number is: 844-866-9378.
